

– Guidelines –

A minimum of two grants in the amount of \$500 each will be awarded during the 2010-2011 school year to students enrolled in a Nebraska college or university and who are active members of a CMENC chapter.

- **Applicants** must be music majors intent upon pursuing a career in music education.
- **Applicants** must be a member of a CMENC collegiate chapter. **Recipients** of the grant must prove active membership in their CMENC chapter, or after June expiration of CMENC, prove first year membership in MENC (half price).
- The grant will be paid directly to the student after the committee has been officially notified by the college or university that student teaching has been **completed** successfully.
- Applications will be accepted for both the fall 2010 and spring 2011 student teaching. The postmark deadline for application is May 1.
- Incomplete or late applications will **not** be accepted.

The completed application packet will include...

- Application form
- Collegiate musical activities resume
- Essay (see application for topic)
- Official college/university transcript
- Two letters of recommendation
- Proof of CMENC membership
